

## LABAC Retrospective.

LABAC ("cabal" spelled backwards) was an informal nonprofit research group that for twenty-two years pooled resources to find and acquire fresh and significant Brilliant Period cut glass catalogs, booklets, photo albums, scrapbooks, advertising, and similar materials. LABAC distributed copies of developed and found materials to members for their personal study and research use. There were over a hundred participants and everyone was welcome to join in this important research effort. The group discontinued its activities early in 2023. Sadly, it became impractical to accomplish the considerable work needed to prepare and publish fresh information as found.

**OPEN MEMBERSHIP.** LABAC was from its 2001 inception open to all individuals and institutions. Anyone wanting to contribute information or work was welcome. Passive participants helped fund operational expenses and received copies of the books periodically published to deploy findings.

**AFFILIATIONS.** LABAC was not affiliated with the ACGA or with any other organization. The ACGA and the Rakow Research Library were encouraged to collaborate to publish reproductions based on some of the original materials found by LABAC, but it was left to these organizations to determine which (if any) materials might be published.

**HOW IT WORKED.** Members collaborated by telephone, e-mail, and letters to find and acquire access to fresh cut glass reference materials and research results from the Brilliant Period. Good photocopies of otherwise inaccessible items were sometimes considered for distribution. Many members helped find material, and all work was done by unpaid volunteers.

For each item found, high quality copies were distributed to members within bound books, for personal research use. Operating costs (e.g., acquisition, reproduction, distribution, and administration) were deducted from subscription receipts until accumulated subscription funds were exhausted. At this point, a new subscription cycle began with a request for subscription renewals and new members. Subscription cycles usually lasted about six to ten months, but duration depended on the quantity of material found, how much the items cost, cumulative cycle book page count, how fast volunteers got books prepared, etc.

**FRESHNESS.** The cut glass information contained in each LABAC book was "fresh," not available to most cut glass collectors from any other source. LABAC made very few spare books at the end of each Cycle.

By participant vote, it was decided during the early cycles that post-publication spare books would be priced at 150% of the corresponding pre-publication Cycle participation fee. Experience suggests that it has become relatively difficult to find used copies of LABAC books that have gone "Out of Print." It was prudent to join each LABAC Cycle before publication, to ensure access to the future book content.

**SUBSCRIPTIONS.** Subscription cycle #1 opened in 2001. The last bound book Cycle #21 closed during Summer 2019. Usual cost of each subscription cycle was \$40, but rare "special circumstances" occasionally increased Cycle costs. Members could request cancellation at any time, and the unused portion of prepaid cycle subscription money was cheerfully refunded, no questions asked. Any LABAC member choosing not to renew their subscription by the cycle closing date was dropped from membership and did not receive subsequent books of materials. Dropout reminders were occasionally sent. The group remained viable until several of the key contributors "aged out."

**DONATIONS.** At cycle close, gratis copies of rediscovered materials in bound book form were donated to the ACGA Reference Library (presently at the Dorflinger Factory Museum), the Rakow Research Library at the Corning Museum of Glass (which was granted microfiche replication but not publication rights), the West Virginia Museum of Glass, and the United States Library of Congress.

Purchased original catalogs were offered to the ACGA for eventual publication to maximize visibility for the material. Most original catalogs acquired by LABAC were donated to the Rakow Research Library. Rakow provides archival preservation facilities and professional management for these old documents. The ACGA retains first right of refusal to reprint the LABAC catalogs donated to the Rakow Research Library. So far, the ACGA has republished two old original catalogs found by LABAC.

**eBOOKS.** LABAC began experimentally publishing electronic books with the 2020 Cycle 22. The objective was to provide worldwide electronic access to LABAC reprinted content from earlier paper books that had gone

"out of print." LABAC eBooks were created during the next 18 months to deploy additional cut glass-related information and research results. These eBooks continue to be distributed through the usual online channels. using the lowest practical costs to promote access and widespread use. Creation of eBooks was suspended late in 2021 due to very low sales volumes at \$3.00 per copy.

ADMINISTRATION. LABAC was organized by Rob and Val Smith. Despite several attempts, they were unable to recruit anyone to continue driving the project. When material became available, members were sometimes asked whether LABAC should buy or borrow, and the applicable maximum cost ceiling. Decisions were usually voted on within two or three days. About Cycle 10, LABAC participants pre-approved purchase of old original catalogs obtainable at "reasonable" cost per page. At the end of each cycle, an operating financial summary was usually sent to participants, so that everyone could see how group resources were used.

SOURCES. Collector reference materials, local auctions, local/regional/national libraries, historical societies, jewelry store archives and family records were exploited by LABAC members to find materials. About half of the rediscovered materials have been loaned by participants. eBay was another significant source. Original catalogs and similar materials still come up several times each year for "web auction" on eBay.

Unpaid volunteers expediently prepared pattern indices for each LABAC book, prior to distribution to participants.

RESULTS. During twenty-two years of active research, LABAC consistently rediscovered encouraging quantities of important information. The Cycle #21 HOP book was the thirty-third and last bound volume of Brilliant Cut Glass information published by LABAC. The group published the following materials:

The priority should be cutting house information, but it is also important to rediscover interesting and useful distributor catalog sections showing cut glass. We invite all cut glass enthusiasts and institutions to join in this important research effort.
